

A workshop in Horse Listening:

Training and problem solving through body language

During this workshop we will explore the reasons behind behavioural problems; particularly focussing on safe handling, awareness of the horse's body language and awareness of our body language. We will use exercises to help common problems such as spooking, barging, napping and loading issues.

Jo has been working with the horse's natural language and innate requirements to improve health and well-being for 12 years. She is an equine complementary therapist (both health and behaviour), a registered BHSIT, and co-ordinator of the Horse Listening Diploma program.

Caroline Baldock spent 4 years working with Monty Roberts on his ranch as his literary adviser, where she helped to research and write his first four books. Caroline was also one of the first professional female jockeys in this country, and is now training young horses at a top show jumping yard in Surrey. Caroline is an expert in equine body language communication, and utilises this when training and working with behavioural problems. In addition, she is currently campaigning to open the first Museum of the Horse in the UK, and has her own website dedicated to this.
